Chief Complaint(s)

Triage Complaint is Abdominal Pain

History of Present Illness (HPI)

The quality is acute. The severity is moderate. The duration is for 2 day(s). Has been at a conference with liberal eating and drinking.. Also notes some blood in stool - dark to black..

Past Medical, Family, and Social History (PFSH)

Medical history from nursing notes reviewed; positive for CAD; positive for heart attack; positive for emphysema. Eczema. Heart disease father with heart disease; mother with heart disease; siblings with heart disease; heart disease. Social history admits frequent alcohol (ETOH) use; admits cigarette/cigar use.

Review of Systems (ROS)

- Constitutional:** Admits to: dizziness.
- Gastrointestinal:** Admits to: nausea.
- Musculoskeletal:** Admits to: back pain.
- Neurological:** No significant abnormality.

All other systems reviewed and were negative.

Physical Exam (PE)

- Constitutional:** Awake, alert, and oriented as to person, place, and time (AAOx3); cooperative; uncomfortable.
- Eyes:** No significant abnormality of the eyes; no eye trauma; pupils are equal and react to light (PERL); eyes exhibit full range of motion (FROM); optic discs are sharp. Vision 20/20 OU.
- ENT:** Normocephalic and atraumatic; no significant abnormality; gag reflex is intact; neck has no meningeal signs.
- Cardiovascular:** Evidence of tachycardia; cardiovascular exam shows no significant abnormality; no gallops; no murmur; regular rhythm; no rubs; skin is dry; skin is warm.
- Respiratory:** Respiratory exam shows no significant abnormality; unlabored respiration; no rales; no rhonchi; no wheezing.
- Gastrointestinal:** LLQ of abdomen reveals high pitched bowel sounds, pain with palpation; and indicates palpable mass. Rectum indicates palpable mass; and has stool in vault. Rectum is positive for melena, stool guaiac test.
- Musculoskeletal:** Musculoskeletal exam shows no significant abnormality; generally normal and intact; motor intact; weightbearing; extremities exhibit full range of motion (FROM). Right leg/left leg reveals edema.
