To room via wheelchair. Patient gowned. Oriented X 3. Respirations not labored. Breath sounds within normal limits. Cardiac rhythm: sinus tachycardia. Abdomen soft and nontender. Absent bowel sounds. Capillary refill is greater than 4 seconds. Extremity pulses are within normal limits. No upper extremity edema. No lower extremity edema. Skin is pale. --14:47 Ethel Gregory, RNP.
